A seasoned Irish actor Michael's screen credits include "Blacksmith" in the sixth season of HISTORY'S VIKINGS, "Senior Barrister William Moore Johnson" in Colm Bairéad's docu-drama "THE MAAMTRASNA MURDERS", and a supporting role in the feature film "THE MAN WHO INVENTED CHRISTMAS" (Netflix) which stars Dan Stevens (Charles Dickens), Christopher Plummer (Scrooge), and Jonathan Pryce (Mr Dickens).

Michael performed in Mouth on Fire's production of Samuel Beckett's "ALL THAT FALL" and "WAITING FOR GODOT" (Pozzo) which toured to two venues in Japan - Theatre X Cai in Tokyo and in Kyoto University Art & Design, Kyoto.
