

## Anna Nugent

Anna plays 'Florence' in Ian Power's debut short film "THE TATTOO" which wrapped filming in Dublin in mid-July. The film is 1 of the 4 Focus Shorts for the Irish Film Board.

She is also cast in TV3's political mini-series "THE BAILOUT" which is directed by Conall Morrison and John Comiskey. It will broadcast on TV3 in the Autumn.

Other Screen credits include 'Lucille Wright' in the feature film "WE HAVE ALWAYS LIVED IN THE CASTLE", directed by Stacie Passon (Post production), 'Emily' in "LAW & ORDER: SVU", Mary Dore's award winning documentary "SHE'S BEAUTIFUL WHEN SHE'S ANGRY", the lead role of 'Penny' in the feature film "CHECKING IN", 'Sarah Palmerston' in Andrew Legge's short film "THE UNUSUAL INVENTIONS OF HENRY CAVENDISH", and the lead role of 'Penelope' in the web series "30,000 TO ONE".

As a talented voice over artiste Anna is the voice of 'Phyllis' in the Irish animated feature "UGLY DUCKLING & ME".

Anna won the Best Actress Award in New York's first Irish Theatre Festival in 2014 for her portrayal of 'Woman' in "THE MCGOWAN TRILOGY", she also performed in the UK premiere which ran in St. Leonards-on-Sea's Kino Theatre. Her Irish theatre credits include "ORSON WELLES CHRISTMAS CAROL", "THE LARAMIE PROJECT", "COLLECTED STORIES", "BOY GETS GIRL", "FEATURING LORETTA", "TAPE" and "ALL IN THE TIMING", 'Helen of Troy' in Mike Finn's "SHOCK & AWE", 'Emily Webb' in "OUR TOWN", "BUMBOG AND BEES", and 'Ophelia' in "HAMLET". Her US theatre credits include 'Sister James' in "DOUBT", the US premiere of Irish playwright and screenwriter Derek O'Conner's one-woman show "MISAPPROPRIATED", "CHECKING IN", "SOMETHING TO REMEMBER ME BY" and "TO FOOL THE EYE".

Anna co-produces the NEWvember New Plays Festival with AboutFACE Ireland, of which she is a founding member. Over the years Anna has led workshops and taught acting in a variety of settings both here in Ireland and in the US, and created the verbatim play "LIVING GRACE".
